

WESTERN RAILWAY OBSERVES WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CAMPAIGN WITH FOCUS ON "ENDING PLASTIC POLLUTION"



Ahmedabad, Western Railway (WR) is observing World Environment Day campaign from 22nd May to 5th June, 2025, with the central theme "Ending Plastic Pollution." According to a press release issued by Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, Shri Vineet Abhishek, a special Launch and Awareness Campaign was conducted from 22nd to 24th May, 2025, encompassing extensive activities across various divisions and workshops. The Meteorological Department has issued an orange alert for rain in 16 districts today. Along with the rain, winds blowing at a speed of 50 to 60 kmph have also been predicted. Heavy rain has been predicted in the state till May 29. Fishermen have been warned not to venture into the sea due to the possibility of strong winds.

Following this complaint, the state government had handed over the investigation to the Surat Vigilance Cell. The Vigilance Department had submitted its preliminary investigation report. 
Orange alert for rain in 16 districts today

While an orange alert has also been given in Sabarkantha, Aravalli, Navsari, Mahisagar, Dahod, Panchmahal, Chhota Udepur, Narmada, Tapi, Dang, Valsad, Dadra and Nagar Haveli today. There is a possibility of light to moderate rain and lightning in Ahmedabad and surrounding areas today. The

wind speed will be 50 to 60 km.
